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## In2Music

Whole-Class Ensemble Tuition (WCET) at KS2

Pre-WCET General Musicianship teaching at KS1 and LKS2

### Standard Package

*Ensure that your school delivers on the National Plan's objectives.*

**£545 per class, per term**

- 10 x 55 min sessions per term (+ 5 mins set-up time) *NB: timings can vary dependent on school and instrument type.*
- 1 tutor
- Class Teacher **must** be present and actively involved in every lesson
- Full class-set of orchestral / percussion instruments:
  - Trumpet
  - Clarinet
  - Recorder
  - Flute
  - Violin
  - Guitar
  - Samba
  - Djembe
  - Ukulele
  - Bamboo Tamboo
  - General Musicianship (KS1 And LKS2) / Curriculum Delivery
- Minimum 1 term (typically 3 terms) per project – flexible by arrangement with the school
- May be possible to change instrument mid-project by arrangement
- Full administrative support from dedicated member of MMF team
- Evidencing of Intent, Implementation and Impact, by arrangement.
- Add / subtract teaching weeks for + / - £54.50 per class per week

**NB:**

*For all 'Standard Package' In2Music projects, the class teacher must be present and actively participate in every session.*

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## PPA Cover Packages

### **QTS Tutor**

*Limited Availability – Staffed by Arrangement*  
**£63.50 per class, per week or £210 per day.**

- 1-hour weekly sessions
- 1 lead tutor with QTS or an equivalent level of in-service experience
- Class set of instruments (as in 'Standard' package)
- Active participation from 1 TA required
- Full administrative support from dedicated member of core MMF team
- Evidencing of Intent, Implementation and Impact, by arrangement.

### **Two Tutors**

*Wider choice of instruments, more support for your pupils.*  
**£93.50 per class, per week**

- 1 hour weekly sessions
- 1 lead tutor and 1 support tutor
- Class set of instruments
- Active participation from 1 TA required
- Full administrative support from dedicated member of core MMF team
- Evidencing of Intent, Implementation and Impact, by arrangement.

## *Rapid Pupil Progress*

### **Carousel Model**

*Small group sizes, pupils rotate termly between 2 or 3 different sets of instruments*  
**2 instrument = £1090 / 3 instrument = £1575 per class, per term**

- 10 x 1 hour sessions per term (NB: not full year)
- One class taught at a time
- 2 tutors or 3 tutors
- One class is split into two or three groups
- 2 or 3 sets of instruments – pupils rotate termly to enable all pupils to try all instruments
- High levels of progress due to small group sizes
- 1 x TA support required
- Additional teaching space(s) required
- Full administrative support from dedicated member of core MMF team
- NB: Can be used as PPA cover by arrangement
- Evidencing of Intent, Implementation and Impact, by arrangement.

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
